Dear Attorney General Sessions,


Attached please find a brief clarifying an extraordinary proceeding filed by We the People under case NO. 1:16-CV-1490 in the Northern District of New York concerning subversion by enemies both foreign and domestic, murder, torture, RICO, concealment, conspiracy to supplant the Law of the Land, denial of due process, non-judicial foreclosures, kidnapping, etc..

The said brief explains We the Peoples' intention to return our Constitutional Article III Courts from jurisdictions unknown back under the Law of the Land. The fact that we need to contact the U.S. Attorney General, concerning the above criminal activities that appear to plague all Federal Courts, to move the courts to respond to these charges demonstrates how dysfunctional and lawless the Federal Judiciary is.

We anticipate a swift written response from you concerning your constitutional duties; and your cooperation to supply us with prosecutors knowledgeable in the common law. If you are unable to find and supply us with such prosecutors we know of at least one qualified common lawyer who was once a prosecutor and still practice's law that we can call upon who is able to prosecute and brief other prosecutors in the practice of common law. We await your written honorable response.
